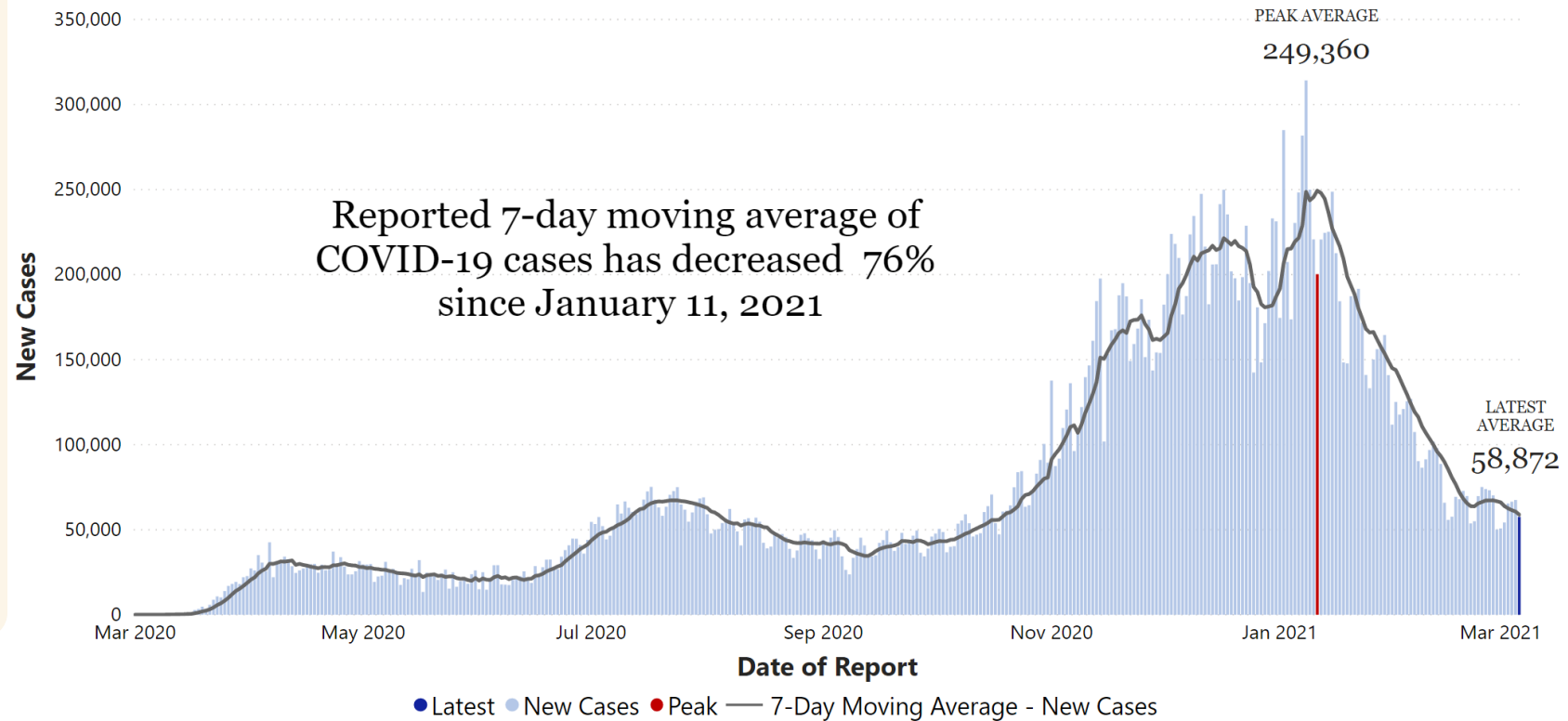

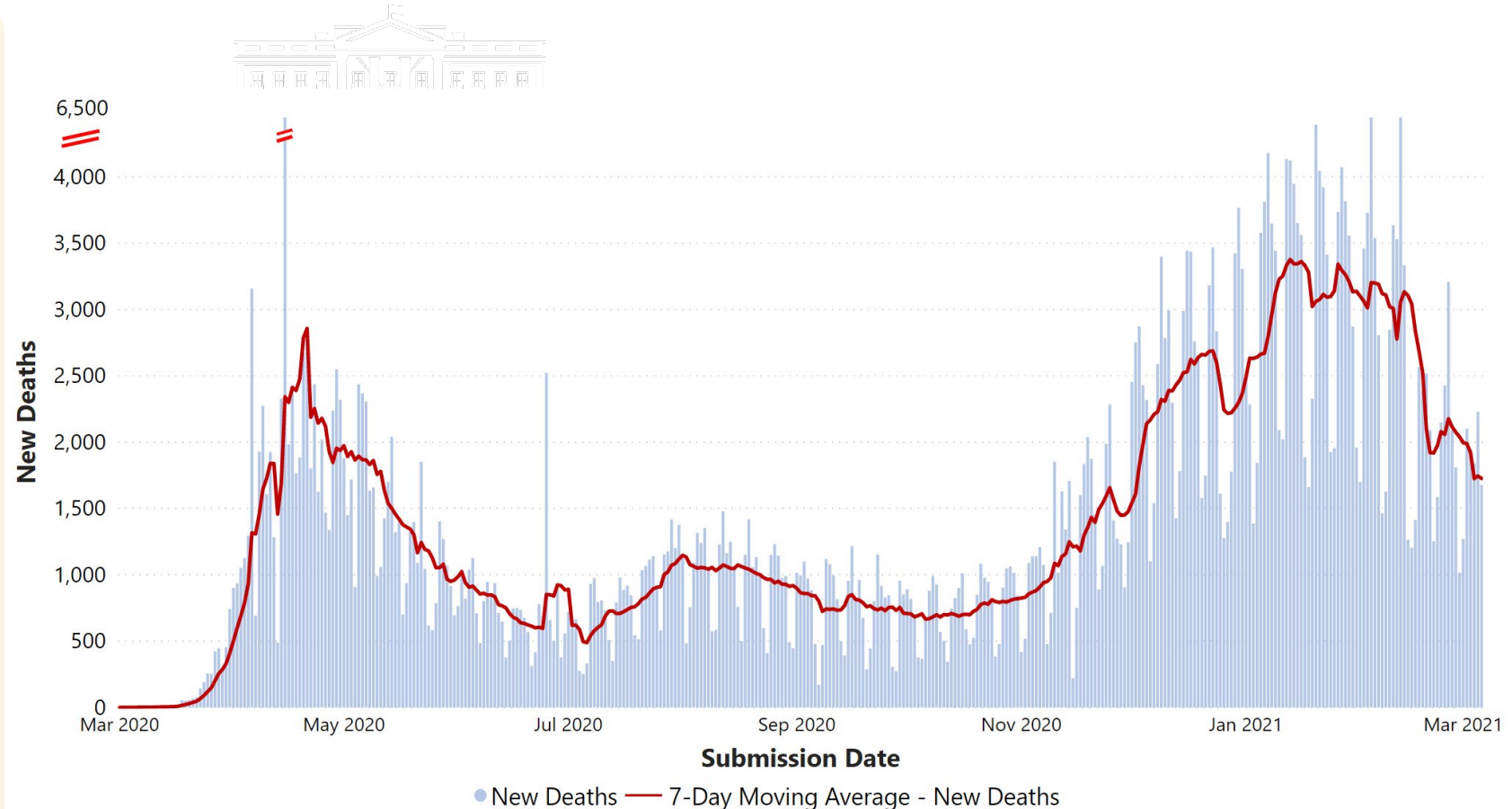

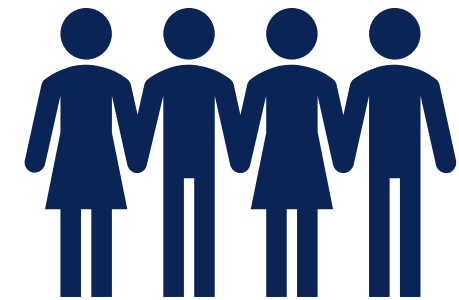

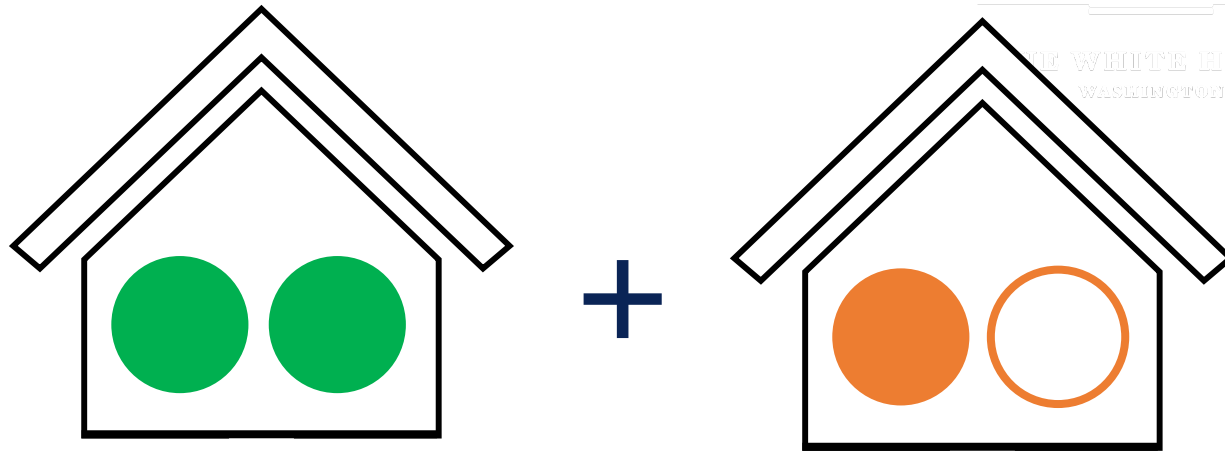

- = unvaccinated and high risk

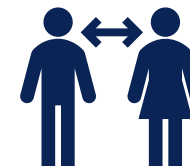

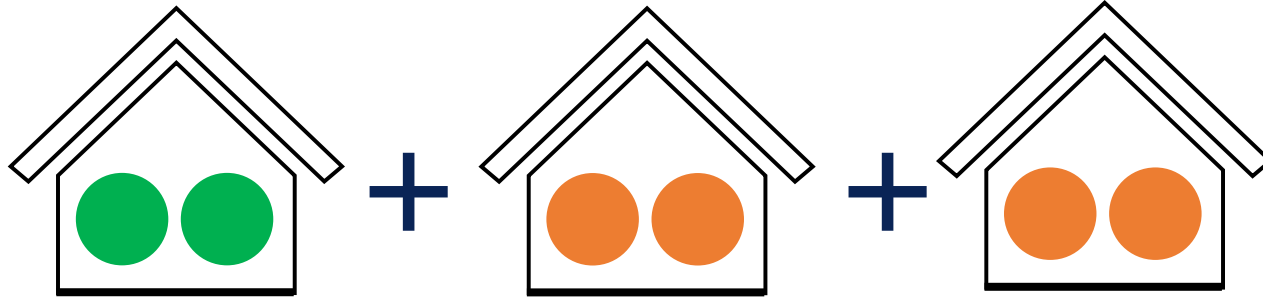

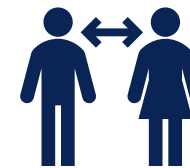

# CDC Guidance Summary

- **Fully vaccinated people can:**

- Visit with other fully vaccinated people indoors, no masks or distancing
- Visit with unvaccinated people from a single household, if low risk, indoors, no masks, no distancing
- Refrain from quarantine and testing following a known exposure to COVID-19 if asymptomatic

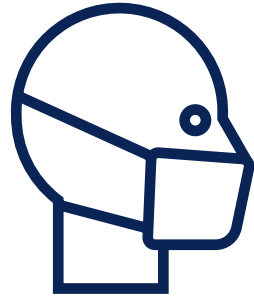


# CDC Guidance Summary

## **For now, fully vaccinated people should continue to:**

- Take precautions in public, mask and distancing
- Masks, distance, and other prevention measures when visiting with unvaccinated people at high risk for severe disease or who have an unvaccinated household member who is at high risk for severe disease
- Masks, distance, and other prevention measures when visiting with unvaccinated people from multiple households
- Avoid medium- and large-sized in-person gatherings
- Get tested if experiencing COVID-19 symptoms
- Follow guidance issued by individual employers
- Follow CDC and health department travel requirements and recommendations

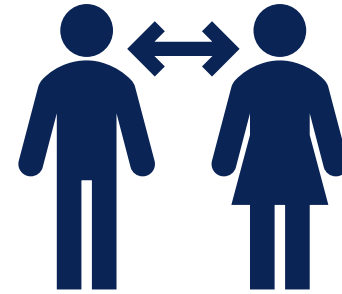




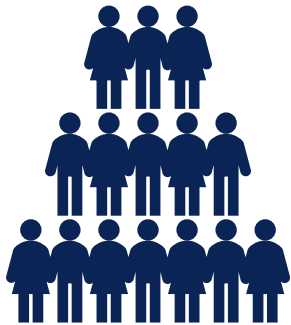
