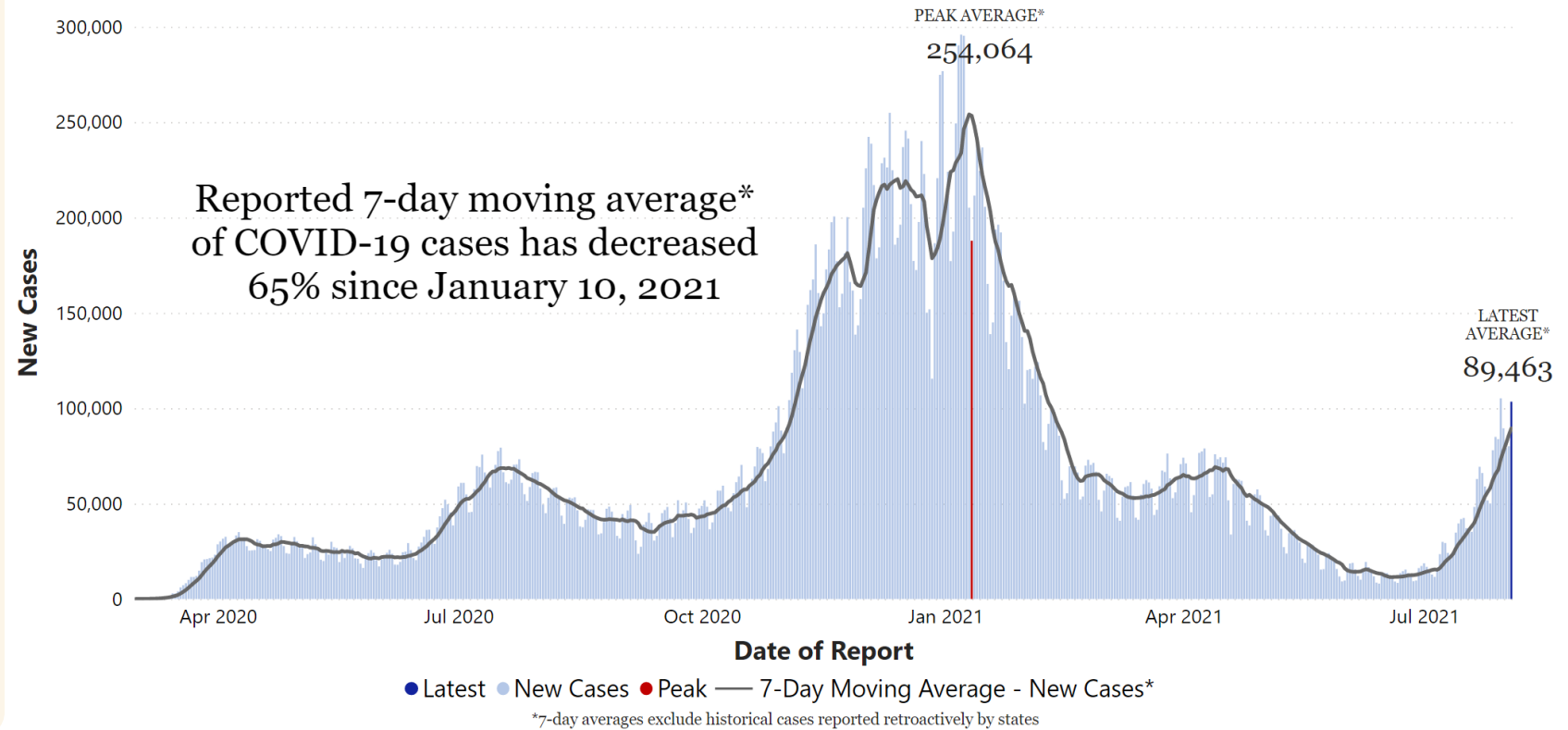

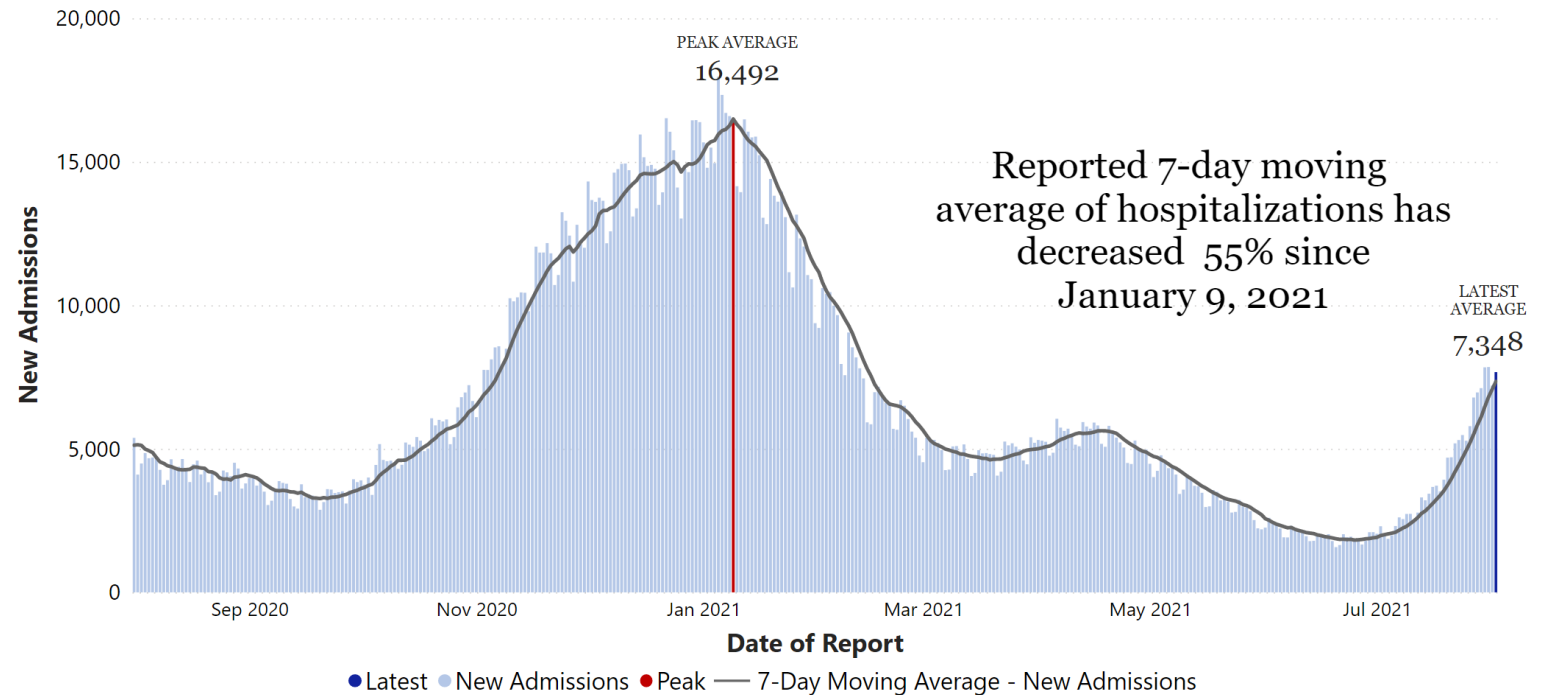

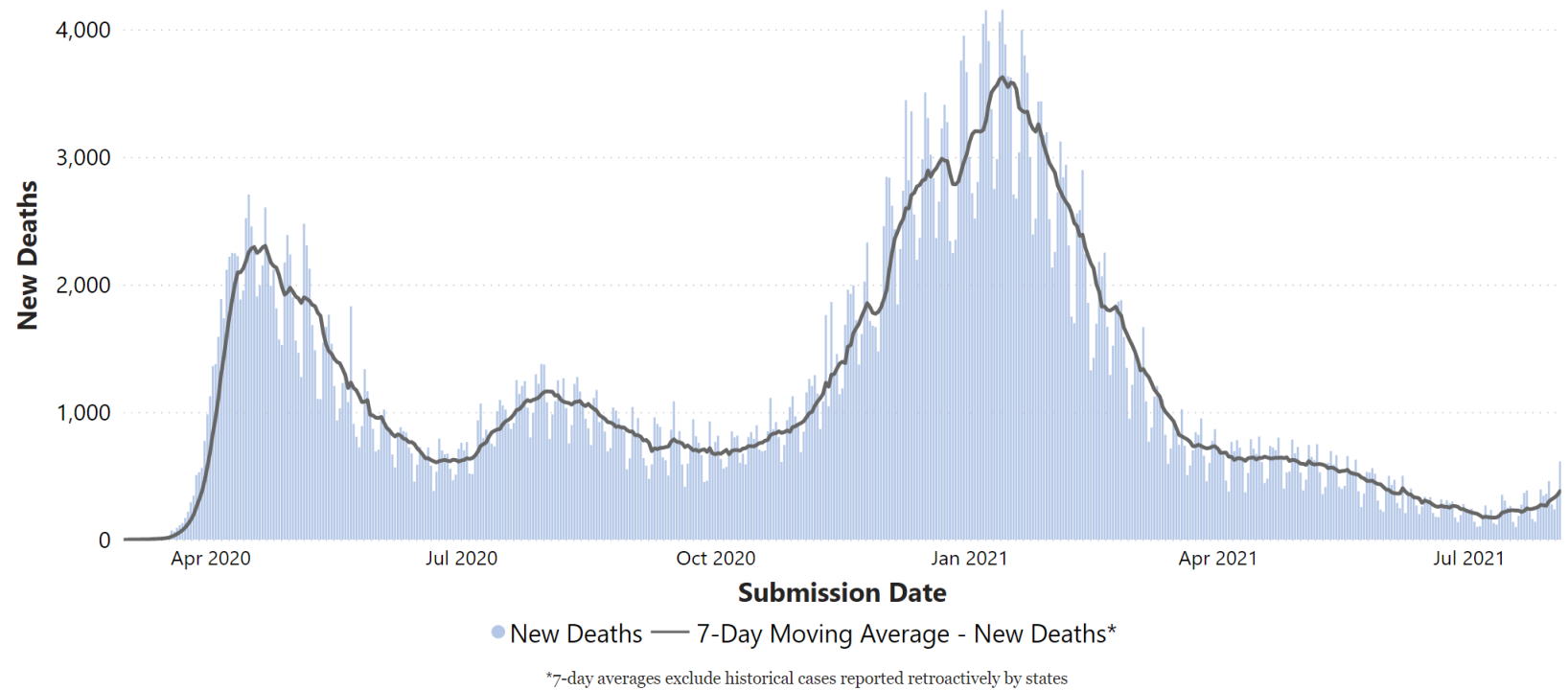

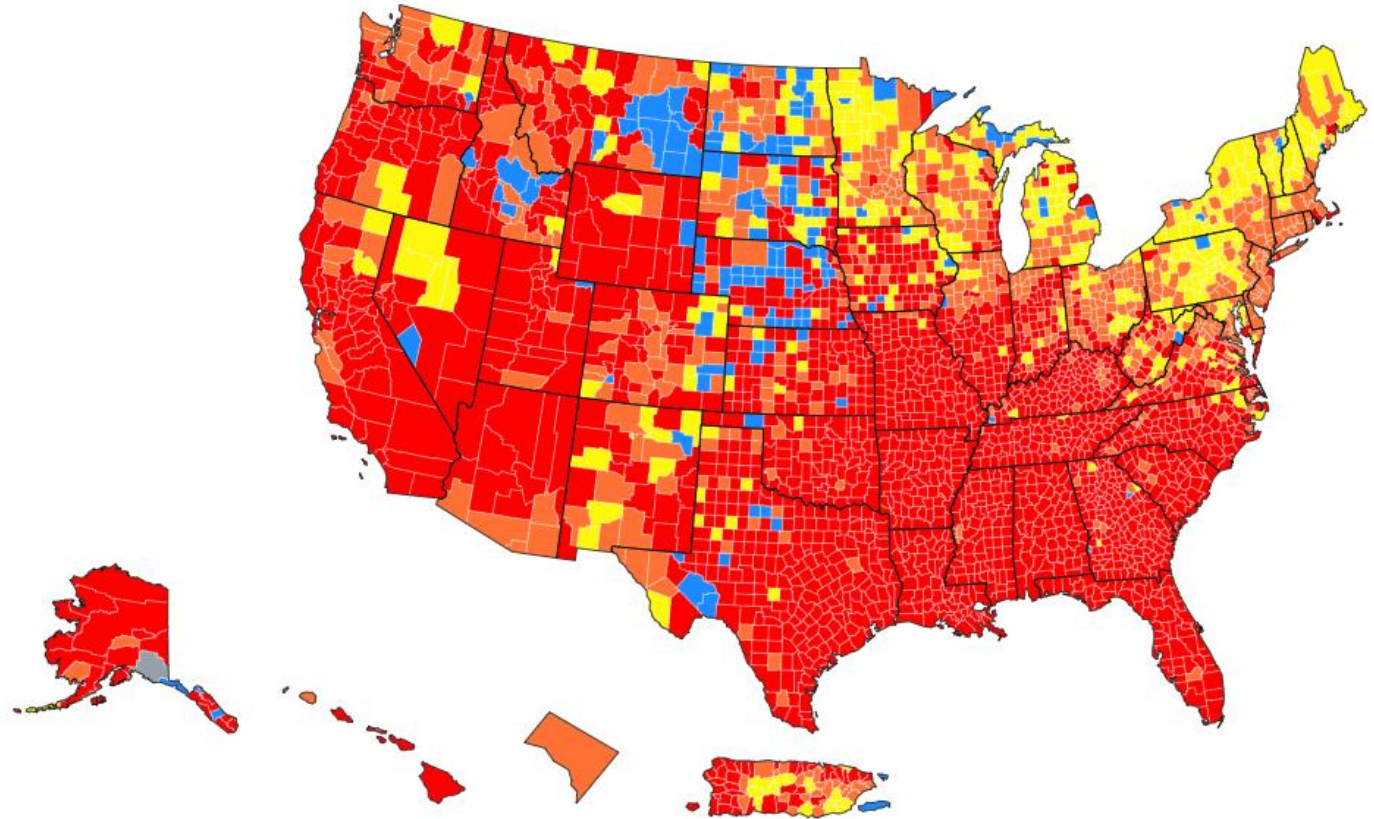


Map of Community Transmission in the United States
