**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled
“Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors”**

This executive order applies COVID-19 safety protocols for Federal employees and on-site contractors to Federal contractors, including those who work offsite. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include enhancing the economy and efficiency of Federal procurement and combatting the spread of COVID-19, thus protecting our country’s health and economy. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2021. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include all applicable executive departments and agencies.
