Statement from OMB Director Shalanda Young

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled "Advancing Effective, Accountable Policing and Criminal Justice Practices to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety"

This executive order would direct a series of Government-wide actions to advance effective, accountable policing and criminal justice practices to enhance public trust and public safety. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include that it sets Federal law enforcement as the standard for effective, accountable policing and takes meaningful steps to strengthen public trust between law enforcement and the communities they serve. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2022. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include all Federal law enforcement agencies, the Department of Health and Human Services, and the Office of Personnel Management.
