Statement from OMB Director Shalanda Young

**Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Order Entitled “Providing for the Closing of Government Departments and Agencies”**

This executive order would close Federal facilities on January 9, 2025 as a mark of respect for President James Earl Carter, Jr., and would treat that day as a holiday for pay-and-leave purposes. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of this executive order include paying respect to President Carter, the thirty-ninth President of the United States. Implementing this executive order would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2025. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by this executive order include all executive departments and agencies.
