Statement from OMB Director Shalanda Young

Budgetary Impact Analysis for Executive Actions Updating Orders of Succession for Twelve Agencies

These executive actions would update the orders of succession for twelve agencies under the Federal Vacancies Reform Act. Implementing these executive actions would have no impact on costs and revenues to the Federal Government. The benefits of these actions would include ensuring consistency with the agencies' current organizational structures and mission needs, and ensuring effective continuity of agency leadership. Implementing these executive actions would have no impact on mandatory and discretionary obligations and outlays, as well as on revenues to the Federal Government, in the 5-year fiscal period beginning in fiscal year 2025. The agencies anticipated to be impacted by these orders include the Department of the Treasury, Department of Justice, Department of Agriculture, Department of Homeland Security, Office of Management and Budget, Office of Science and Technology Policy, Council on Environmental Quality, U.S. Agency for International Development, Office of the National Cyber Director, U.S. International Development Finance Corporation, Office of Personnel Management, and U.S. Agency for Global Media.
